Alan Jeffery Freeman, age 64, of Marionville, MO passed away peacefully in his sleep on Friday, May 5, 2023, in his home. He was born in Hutchinson, Kansas on Friday, June 27, 1958; son of Robert "Bob" Freeman and Jonelle "Jo" Hill. Jeff had a long and rich career in radio serving as program director and on-air talent at radio stations in Little Rock, Springfield, Wichita, Pittsburg, Joplin, Tulsa and was later recognized consistently as the top-producing salesperson at K95 FM. Jeff was an incredibly talented drummer and co-founded the Kow Kountry Band where he performed at many venues in the four-state area, and in recent years enjoyed playing drums in his church worship band. Jeff was known by those around him for being an intelligent, fun-loving, selfless, and incredibly giving person who loved both the Lord and people very much.
