Bettie Lucretia Hall, 89, of Big Spring, TX and formerly of Aurora, MO passed away on March 24, 2014, in Big Spring, TX. She was born May 13, 1924, in rural Lawrence County, MO; the youngest of five children of Walter E. and Amarilla Thompson. She was married on October 9, 1943, in Lawrence County, MO to Everett Hall who preceded her in death on December 18, 1989.
