Candace Ann Whitlock, age 63, of Monett, MO died on Saturday, June 21, 2014, at Bentonview Park Health and Rehab in Monett, MO. Candy was born in Monett, MO on Friday, July 28, 1950. She was the daughter of David H. and Margaret (Rainey) Whitlock. Miss Whitlock was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Monett where she was loved and was everyone's friend. Miss Whitlock retired in September 2013, from the Monett Sheltered Workshop where she had worked for 42 years.
