Clyde Robert Stephens, 90, of Wentworth, Missouri passed away unexpectedly but peacefully at home on June 17, 2022. Clyde was born in Wentworth, Missouri to Verney Ray Stephens and Luna Pearl (Griffin) Stephens on April 30, 1932. Clyde married Kay Erwin on June 17, 1951 at the Presbyterian Church of Wentworth.

Following graduation from Sarcoxie High School in 1950, Clyde proudly served in the United States Air Force for 26 years and 13 days. Most of his military career was within the Security Service (Intelligence) division where he was stationed overseas in the Philippines, Alaska (twice), Vietnam and Germany. Upon retirement from the military in San Antonio, Texas effective August, 1976, Clyde returned to his Wentworth home and continued to eagerly serve his community as an active member of the Village of Wentworth council for over 44 years.

Clyde was preceded in death by his parents, two older brothers, Thomas Gene and Sterling Stephens and sister, Allis Armstrong, plus, sons-in-law, Calvin Weiss and Marc Roberson.

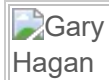
