David H. Whitlock, age 90, of Monett, MO died on Wednesday, August 15, 2018, at Lacoba Homes Inc. in Monett, MO. Mr. Whitlock was born in Monett, MO on Saturday, August 27, 1927. 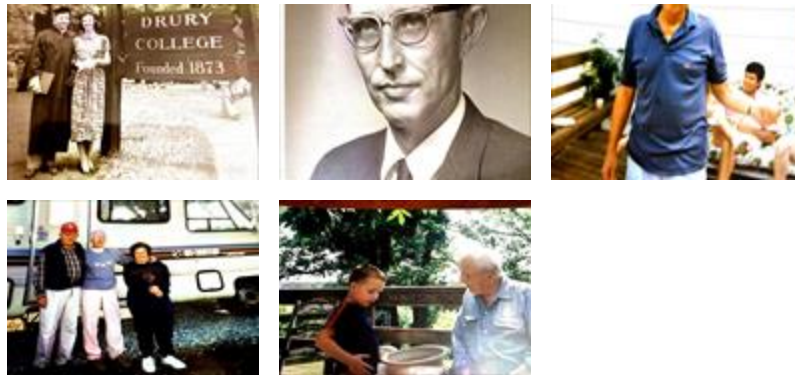
