Doug Weatherly, age 44, of Monett, MO died on Monday, December 13, 2010, at Freeman Hospital in Neosho, MO. Mr. Weatherly was born on Tuesday, January 18, 1966, in Springfield, MO. He was son of the late David Weatherly and Mary Lou (Kirby) McGeehee. He married Joni Ellison on July 29, 1989, in Branson, MO. Mr. Weatherly was a member of First United Methodist Church in Monett., He graduated from Marionville High School in 1984, then graduated from Evangel College in Springfield, MO and received his Masters Degree, from William Woods College in Fulton, MO. Mr. Weatherly had been a coach and teacher in the Pierce City School system for 22 years.

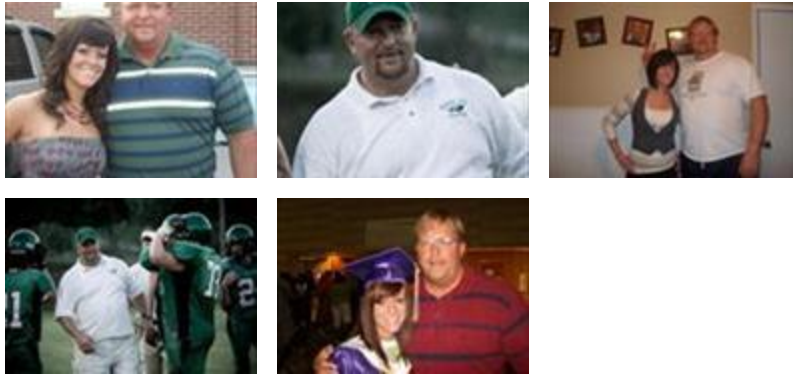

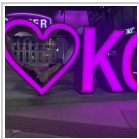
