



Elda Alden Rosenbaum

July 14, 1920 - September 9, 2010

Elda Alden Rosenbaum, age 90, of Stockton, MO, passed from this life to his eternal reward on Thursday, September 9, 2010, at 6:30 AM. He was born July 14, 1920, to Boyd and Corda (Peach) Rosenbaum on a farm five miles west of Stockton, MO.

He attended school at Excelsior School. He joined the United States Coast Guard on June 10, 1942, and served our country during World War II. He was stationed out of Peoria and Joliet, IL and helped take supplies down the Mississippi. He was also stationed on the USS Aquarius, a manned supply vessel in the Pacific theatre. He received an honorable discharge on November 26, 1945. While in Joliet, he met and married the love of his life, Margaret Theola Stole on November 11, 1943. In January 1946, they bought the "old Stinson farm" where they made their home for sixty six years, south of Stockton, and raised their two daughters, Melodye Kay and Corda Julia. As their health declined, they have spent the last nine months in the Ash Grove Healthcare Facility.

Elda loved farm life. He enjoyed his cattle, working the soil, clearing land, going to sales, and all other aspects of the farm and country life. He loved the Lord and served Him faithfully. He was saved in 1954, and was a long time member of Stockton Assembly of God Church where he served on the church deacon board for many years. He was an excellent husband, father, grandfather, neighbor, and friend. In his later years, he enjoyed the coffee shop and the Korth Senior Center.

He was survived by his loving and devoted wife, Margaret (Marge); two daughters and their husbands: Melodye and Ralph Snider of Willard, MO, and Corda and Randy Hayward of Stockton, MO; five grandchildren and their spouses: Brenda and Scott Lakin, Brad and Teresa Hayward, Christy and Gregg Bates, Julie and JR Woods, and Carson and Lindsey Hayward; four great-grandchildren: Paige, Britney, Jackson, and Elias.

He is preceded in death by his parents; two brothers and their spouses, Howard and Opal Rosenbaum and Melvin and Rosa Lee Rosenbaum; one sister and husband, Mabel and Clyde Bough.

A celebration of his life will be held on Monday, September 13, 2010, at 11:00 AM at the Stockton Assembly of God Church with Pastor Randy Hayward officiating.
