Everal Herbert Larkham, age 82, of Wentworth, MO passed away on Saturday, January 8, 2022, at Cox-Monett in Monett, MO. He was born in Norwich, CT on Monday, February 13, 1939; son of William Herbert and Dorothy (Murray) Larkham. Mr. Larkham graduated from Norwich Free Academy in 1957.
