Gary Leon Gunter, age 85, of Pierce City, MO died on Monday, January 27, 2020 at his home in Pierce City, MO. Mr. Gunter was born in Scandia, KS on Monday, December 10, 1934. He was the son of Parley and Thelma (Howell) Gunter. Mr. Gunter graduated from Pierce City High School in 1953. He attended a year of college at SMS in Springfield, MO. He was married to Phyllis Palmer on Saturday, June 15, 1957 in Pierce City, MO. Mr. Gunter spent over 39 years in the Army where he was a Master Sergeant. During his years in the Army, he traveled to Korea and was later in the National Guard. In 1962, Mr. Gunter was presented a Missouri National Guard award for outstanding achievement by the St. Louis Post Dispatch. He was passionate about his grandkids and loved spending time watching them play ball. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, golfing, and anything outdoors. Mr. Gunter was a member of the Sportsman Club where he served on the board. He was an avid reader. He would read 2 or 3 books a week. Mr. Gunter was a member of the Pierce City First United Methodist Church. He enjoyed watching girls college basketball, the Pierce City Eagles, and the Kansas City Chiefs.

Surviving are the following: his wife, Phyllis of the home; two sons, Mark Gunter of Nixa, MO and Gary Gunter of Monett, MO; one daughter, Michel Garman and Doug Shelley of Pierce City, MO; twelve grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and a son, Greg Gunter.
