Rev. Grady Allen Cockerham, age 84, of Monett, MO died on Tuesday, August 09, 2011, at his home in Monett, MO. Rev. Cockerham was born in Hornbeck, LA on Friday, March 25, 1927. He was the son of Charles Grady and Alma (McInnis) Cockerham. Rev. Cockerham was married to Archie Imogene "Jean" Townson in Beaumont, TX on August 10, 1945. He was a Southern Baptist Minister and a member of Bethel Baptist Church, near Monett. He served his country as a Sergeant during WW II.
