He was owner of the Merritt Cleaners in Pierce City, MO and owned and operated Pierce City School buses for many years. He served in the MO National Guard for over forty years and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Pierce City, MO.

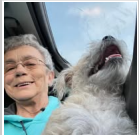

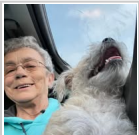
