



## Lorene Frances Pierce

September 25, 1926 - October 7, 2020

Lorene Frances Pierce, 94, of Pulaskifield, MO passed away suddenly on Wednesday, October 07, 2020 just nine days following the passing of her husband of 67 years. The eleventh and final child of Joseph and Frances (Yunker) Rosewicz was born on September 25, 1926 on the family farm south of Pulaskifield.

James Edward Pierce and Lorene Frances Rosewicz were married May 16, 1953 as the first wedding couple in the re-built SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Pulaskifield. The church had suffered a fire the previous year. In their 67 years of marriage, they lived in Kansas for 34 years and back to Missouri for 33 years, retiring to a homeplace just a quarter of a mile from where they were married.

As well as a loving spouse, Lorene was a loving mother. She was Den Mother to her two cub scouts, attended all of the summer little league baseball games through her son's high school football and basketball games. She was always there!

Lorene leaves behind two sons: Jim (Pam) Pierce of El Dorado, Kansas and Joe (Mary) Pierce of Wichita, Kansas; one sister-in-law, Bernice Rosewicz of Kansas City, Kansas; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, grand-nieces and grand-nephews.
