



## Ludon Brattin

August 18, 1925 - September 3, 2014

Ludon Brattin, age 89, of Wheaton, MO died on Wednesday, September 03, 2014, at his home near Wheaton, MO. Mr. Brattin was born in Barry County MO, on Tuesday, August 18, 1925. He was the son of Dayton and Cora (Ruppert) Brattin. Mr. Brattin married Helen Elkins on Sunday, June 25, 1950, in Wheaton, MO. He was Wheaton Fire Chief, served on the city council, was a coach of the Wheaton ball program, was a member of the Lion's Club, received an Honorary FFA degree, and was the C.F.I. Driver of the Year in 1978.

Surviving are the following: his wife, Helen of the home; one daughter, Brenda Rowe and husband, John, of Joplin, MO; two sons: Jon Brattin of Wheaton, MO and Joe Brattin and wife, Angela, of Fairview, MO; two sisters: Barbara Haynes of Springfield, MO and Lorene Licklider of Cassville, MO; seven grandchildren; and ten great-grandchildren. Mr. Brattin was preceded in death by his daughter, Sarah Wilson, in 1998.
