



## Patrick "Pat" Lee Myers

May 23, 1953 - May 19, 2015

Patrick Lee "Pat" Myers died peacefully at his home on May 19th, 2015 in Slaughterville, OK at the age of 61. He donated his body to science and cremation has taken place.

Except for a brief 2 year period in the early 90's, Pat worked for 29 years at American Waterworks Supply from 1984 through April of 2015. He became a respected member of the waterworks industry throughout Oklahoma.

Pat was a lifelong bachelor and avid fisherman; he particularly enjoyed fly fishing. He was a Mason; and enjoyed volunteering. He spoke often of visiting children at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Burn Center in Galveston, TX.
