He was the son of Ray and Charlene (Garoute) Perry. He devoted his life to law enforcement. He served as a deputy sheriff for two years in Lawrence County, served in the U.S. Army for three years, 9 years of service at Branson Police Department as a detective, and 8 years as chief deputy sheriff of Taney County. Mr. Perry was at one time an member of the Taney County Shrine Club, Masonic Lodge, and a member of the Scottish Rite.
