



## Robert "Bob" Lemuel Hilton

April 12, 1922 - January 28, 2012

Bob Hilton, age 89, of Scottsdale, AZ died on Saturday, January 28, 2012, in Scottsdale, AZ. Bob was born in Crane, MO, on April 12, 1922. Bob went to Ritchey Elementary School, graduated from Midway High School, and attended Missouri Southern State College in Joplin, MO. He served his country in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II. He was a member of the Camelback Church of Christ in Phoenix, AZ.

Bob married Malcodene Miller, who survives him, on Sept. 4, 1943. Following their marriage, he worked for Curtiss Candy Company and Purex Corporation in Springfield, MO. They then moved to Salt Lake City, Utah, where Bob was employed by Lewis Pet Food, which was bought by National Can Corporation. He was then made regional sales manager and transferred to southern California for eight years and then, in 1969, to Arizona. After retirement in 1987, Bob enjoyed playing softball on the senior softball team in Scottsdale. He collected hundreds of baseball caps from all over the world. He was a beloved uncle of his many nieces and nephews, who live throughout the U.S. Bob was blessed with a happy, outgoing personality. He loved people and animals, and they loved him.
