Sam Dalton, age 81 of Pierce City, MO went on to be with his Lord on Thursday, September 05, 2019 after succumbing to injuries sustained from a car accident on August 24th, he received excellent care at Evelyn's (Hospice) House in Creve Coeur, MO.
