Wayne J. Sooter, age 66, of Pierce City, MO died on Monday, November 16, 2015, at Freeman Health System West in Joplin, MO. Wayne Sooter was born in Stella, MO on Sunday, June 26, 1949. 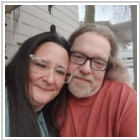
